

1100 BOARD OF EDUCATION BY-LAWS
1140 OFFICERS

A. Election and Term of Office

The Board of Education shall hold an organizational meeting within fifteen (15) days of each regular biennial election for the purpose of electing a President, a First Vice President, and a Second Vice President from among its members. Election may be by secret ballot. Those elected shall serve for a period of two (2) years or until successors are elected and qualified.

The Board of Education, at its discretion, shall elect or appoint a Secretary and a Treasurer or a Secretary-Treasurer. Those elected shall serve for a period of two (2) years or until his/her successor has been elected and qualified. If appointed, the appointee serves at the discretion of the Board.

Legal Counsel, an Auditor, a Medical Advisor, and a district negotiator shall be appointed within sixty (60) days of this meeting.

Representation on the Englewood Parks and Recreation Commission, the City-School Committee, and other boards and commissions upon which the Board of Education has a delegate shall also be elected at this organizational meeting.

B. Duties of Board Officers

1. The President

The President, in addition to the duties prescribed by law, shall exercise such other powers as properly appertain to his/her office or as may be delegated to him/her by the Board of Education.

2. The Vice-President

In the absence or inability of the President, the First Vice-President shall have and perform all of the powers and duties of the president. In the absence or inability of the President and the First Vice-President, the Second Vice President shall have and perform all of the powers and duties of the President.

3. The Secretary

The Secretary to the Board shall perform those duties as enumerated.

4. The Treasurer

The Treasurer shall furnish the bond and perform the duties prescribed by law and such other duties as may be delegated to him/her by the Board.
