

- A. The District shall maintain a strong program of accountability to the public including advisement and monitoring by a District Advisory Accountability Committee, advisement and monitoring of schools by School Advisory Accountability Committees, and annual reports to the public related to the quality of education provided by the District.
- B. The District will annually publish aggregated student achievement data based upon the attainment of District standards and disaggregated data for minority groups whose enrollment exceeds 10. No information shall be reported which allows for the identification of individual students.
- C. Each school shall participate in a systematic review by a visiting team at least once every three years. Minimally the team will involve students, parents/families, accountability committee members, business leaders, and educators from other Districts or approved management entities.
