

All voting at any meeting shall be by roll call. The names of the members shall be called alphabetically, and each member present shall orally vote "Aye" or "No" upon each question unless excused from voting by the Board for a good cause.

All motions will be considered lost unless they receive a second and an affirmative vote is given by the majority of the members present.
