

- A. The Board of Education recognizes the right of free expression on the part of the citizens living in the School District. Petitions and communications may be presented at any Board meeting or filed at any time in the Superintendent's office. Petitions and communications requiring Board of Education action should be filed in the Office of the Superintendent, or with the Secretary of the Board of Education and copies provided to members of the Board of Education at least one (1) week prior to the time of the meeting.
- B. The President may allocate an appropriate time limit for the presentation and discussion of citizen concerns at each regular Board of Education meeting.
