

In cases when action must be taken and the Board has provided no guides in policy for such action, the Superintendent shall have the power to act. The Superintendent's decisions, however, shall be subject to review by the Board at its next regular meeting. It shall be the duty of the Superintendent to inform the Board promptly of such action and of the need for policy.

In situations which arise within individual schools where the Board of Education or its Superintendent has provided no guides for administrative action, the Principal shall have power to act. The Principal's action should be based upon the advice and counsel of the Superintendent and staff or representatives thereof when such advice is available and deemed desirable.
