

- A. The District shall provide home or hospital instruction for students who are unable to attend school because of an illness or injury. The District also makes home instruction available as an option for pregnant students who cannot attend due to physical or emotional reasons. Instruction will occur in the home, hospital setting or alternate setting (e.g. library, etc.) If instruction occurs in the home, an adult over 18 years of age must be present with the student and the homebound teacher.

- B. Handicapped students who are unable to attend school as determined by a "staffing" shall be provided home instruction in keeping with the requirements set forth in the student's Individual Educational Program (I.E.P.).
