

Continuing Enrollment of Students who Become Nonresidents

A student who has been enrolled in a District school shall be entitled to complete the current semester or other term of credit if he/she becomes a non-resident; or if he/she becomes a non-resident after completing eleventh grade or while enrolled in the twelfth grade, he/she shall be entitled to finish twelfth grade as a resident. Students who have become non-residents and who seek to continue enrollment in the District beyond the current semester's enrollment must apply and receive approval as indicated in JFBB, Inter-District Choice/Open Enrollment.
