All types of bullying are regarded as unacceptable. Bullying is defined as any written or verbal expression, physical act or gesture, or a pattern thereof, that is intended to cause distress upon one or more students in the school environment, on school vehicles, bus stops, or at school activities or sanctioned events. The superintendent or his designee shall develop a comprehensive program to address bullying at all school levels.
