

Any initiation or other activity that interferes in any way with the proper functioning of the school program is considered hazing. Hazing is prohibited, including hazing activities, i.e., forcing prolonged physical activity, forcing excessive consumption of any substance, forcing prolonged deprivation of sleep, food, or drink, or any other behavior which recklessly endangers the health or safety of an individual for purposes of initiation into any student group.

No student, or other person, shall conspire to engage in hazing, participate in hazing or commit any act that injures, degrades or disgraces or tends to injure, degrade or disgrace any student.
