SCHOOL PROGRAM**

The mission of the OPPORTUNITIES-CHOICES Program is to help Flood students achieve success by providing them with appropriate resources and assistance designed to meet their academic needs. The ultimate goal is to support students in becoming independent learners by:

- \*Providing opportunities for reinforcement of course concepts and skills.
- \*Reinforcing and supplementing classroom instruction.
- \*Improving learning efficiency and effectiveness.
- \*Supporting faculty in their work with students.
- \*Creating learning communities.

**OPPORTUNITIES**

Ultimately, OPPORTUNITIES will help close the achievement gap and meet our AYP target. Academic focus will be science (8th grade only), math and reading.

**OPPORTUNITIES** will provide supplemental services and give extra support to the kids who need the most help. The program will be held after school, Wednesdays and Thursdays, from 3:10-4:00 pm. Each session lasts 6 weeks.

The classes will be multi-grade and students will be placed according to their needs. There is a referral process to help keep numbers manageable (around 15 per class). We will have a late bus, for those students who currently ride the school bus, which leaves at 4:05.

**CHOICES**

This program is for students who are currently testing at a proficient level but are failing two or more classes. Students will attend this program until grades are C's or better. The class will be limited to 16 students. When a student reaches the goal of C's or better (s)he will no longer be required to attend and that slot will be designated to another student. The program will be held after school, Wednesdays and Thursdays, from 3:10-4:00 pm. Each session lasts 6 weeks. We will have a late bus, for those students who currently ride the school bus, which leaves at 4:05.
