Disciplinary action will be based on an individual basis.

If suspension is the appropriate consequence, a parent conference must be held prior to reinstatement.

Student dress - FOR SCHOOL

Families are urged to make reasonable choices in the clothes that are selected **for school**. A neat, clean appearance is the most desirable. It should be recognized that hair styles, any apparel, or lack of, which draws undue attention to the wearer and/or tends to detract from the educational process is therefore, inappropriate. Flood Middle School staff reserve the right to require that students modify their dress if it is disruptive or inappropriate for the a public school setting.

- No headware, sunglasses, or walkmans are to be worn in the building.
- Jackets/coats are to be kept in lockers.
- No bare midriiffs, no spaghetti straps.
- No clothing, jewelry, etc., with inappropriate phrases, items or logos that advertise, display or represent alcoholic beverages, tobacco, durgs, obscenities or sex.
- No short shorts or cutoffs.
- No outer garments which allow exposure of undergarments.
- No inappropriately tight or excessively torn clothing. No saggy pants.
- Basketball jerseys or "tank tops" must be worn with a shirt underneath
- No clothing that distracts from the learning process.

Gang activity

- **Dress, signs**
- **"Presenting yourself as a member of a gang"**

The Englewood Schools are committed to 'zero tolerance' for gangs and gang related activities. This means that the school will take appropriate action, including: Suspension, expulsion and referral to police for gang-related behaviors of any kind. This includes clothing altered in ways that are associated with gang affiliation. Such clothing may be confiscated and turned over to law enforcement authorities.

Detention [May be issued by any staff member, for behavior problems and/or poor choices.] All detentions are to be served the day they are assigned.

- Thirty minutes of study time after school.
- Failure to serve = time doubled 1st time.
- Failure to serve 2nd time = defiance.

Cafeteria [The breakfast and lunch programs are privileges extended to all students.]

Gymnasiums [The use of the gyms at lunch is privileges extended to all students.]
